

Only a few more weeks until the big recital! We can't believe how fast this year is going. We want to thank everyone that made it for the pictures last week, they turned out great!

Culture Fest is NEXT Saturday, June 4th! Our performance time was just confirmed for 11am, so please plan on arriving by 10:50 so we are organized and ready to go right at 11am. If your child is in a combo class they should be ready to do tap first and then ballet. The stage will be located just north of Main Street & Bridge. I am told there will be open parking by the library and the armory. They do block quite a few streets in that area so plan for some delays. Full costume, pink tights, ballet/tap shoes and hair pulled into a bun!

Our recital is just around the corner on June 25th (Sat.) at Fort Lupton Middle School. The show will begin at 3 pm and run about an hour.

Each class will get rehearsal time on the stage prior to this time. It's important to get this time so the girls are comfortable and know where they need to be! You can drop your child off and return for the show – Just let Christina or Cathrine know if you will be leaving.

Make-up needs to be worn and hair must be pulled back into a bun.

Please allow time to get ready either before or after the stage rehearsal time that is listed. Please bring a healthy snack to the theatre.

No Flash photography is allowed during the show!

As usual a video will be made; a sign-up sheet will be at the front of the theatre. Videos cost \$10 each.

We have regular classes going all summer! It's really beneficial for the kids to come to class over the summer, this is when they have the best opportunity to work on technique and learn new steps. Also through the summer, we are going to "open" our classes so your child may attend any class in their age group. Example: If she is 4 years old and normally comes to the Tuesday 6:30 class but you are going to be out of town she can take the Wed 6:30 class or Thurs 5:15 class instead. Or she can come Tues 6:30 & Thurs 5:15 one week and be out the next. Another exciting thing we are offering this summer, to our girls 7 years and older, is an opportunity to come and take class with the next level up! The girls are invited, twice a month for July and August, to attend class with the level above them. There is no extra cost for this, just come and take a class, learn something new, and maybe make a few new friends! Specific dates for this will be posted.

Speaking of making new friends, last year we had a big slumber party at the studio to close out the summer. It was such a success that we are doing it again! Our 2nd annual "End of Summer Slumber Party" will be Friday, August 12. This is open to all girls 5 years and older. Look for information flyers and sign-up sheets at the studio in June.

Before we know it, we will begin working on routines for The Nutcracker recital.

A big thank you goes out to the parents and grandparents who have gotten the girls to classes, helped them with those "tricky" steps and learned the dances themselves while practicing with their kids. Your work has paid off, the girls look fantastic. You will be so proud when you see them up there on the stage doing their dances!
